Consultancy

The Institute completed the following five consultancy assignments during the year: (i) Restructuring Khadi & Village Industries Commission, (ii) Restructuring of Central Government Medical Services, (iii) Trade Related Entrepreneurship Assistance and Development for Women, (iv) Emergency Health Care Load in Selected Hospitals of Delhi, and (v) Development and Implementation of Computers Software in Selection of Teachers and Principals of Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan. Details are given in Annexure I under Section "B".

Details of contributions other than research and consultancy of faculty as well as library professional staff are given in Annexure II.

Training

The Institute during the year organised 73 training programmes as compared to 71 in 1994-95, 67 in 1993-94 and 61 in 1992-93. This is the highest number of training programmes organised so far. In addition, the Institute also organised the 21st Advanced Professional Programme in Public Administration. Great attention is being paid to maintain high quality in all the programmes. The Institute has been actively collaborating with State Training Institutes. During the year, courses on Case Preparation and Use were organised at Shimla, Shillong and Goa and the Himachal Pradesh, Meghalaya State Institutes of Administration and Goa University were associated with this activity.

National Centre for Disaster Management

The National Centre for Disaster Management (NCDM) set up with the support of the Ministry of Agriculture, Government of India, continued its activities as an integral part of the Institute.

The NCDM during the year conducted five training programmes and two national conferences on different themes and has planned a comprehensive programme of activities during the coming year. A detailed account of the Centre's activities finds place in the Annual Report.

Conferences/Seminars/Workshops

The Institute organised eleven conferences/seminars/workshops and discussion-lectures on different themes during the year. A two-day workshop on "Dimensions of Public Management" was conducted jointly with Maharashtra Regional Branch at Bombay on May 16-17, 1995. As part of the 40th Anniversary Programme of the Institute, a seminar on "Policy Choices for Democracy: Decentralisation and Village Self-Determination" was organised on September 6, 1995. The Institute organised a seminar on "Directions of Reform of India's Parliamentary System" on September 29, 1995.

A colloquium on "Union-State Relations" was organised by the Institute on October 9, 1995.

A workshop on "Women and Children in Disaster" was organised on October 11, 1995 by the Institute's National Centre for Disaster Management (NCDM). Another workshop on "Himalayan Eco-Development and National Disaster Reduction" was organised by the NCDM on November 27-28, 1995. A two-day workshop on "Effective Policing of the National Capital Territory of Delhi and Adjoining Areas" was organised by the Institute under the auspices of Bureau of Police Research and Development,
