The institute has an area of 10 acres. The Institute has a wide variety of mango plants inside the campus. The Institute intends to auction the mangoes produced/grown on campus. The interested firms or individuals are encouraged to participate in the auction. The Auction Notice/Document may be downloaded from the Institute Website or the CPP portal and also collect from the Campus Management office of the campus. **The bidders must submit their bids in sealed envelope addressed to the Joint Director, NIDM Southern Campus at Campus Management Office of the Campus.**

Terms and Conditions.

- a) The auction is for harvesting mangoes from 114 mango trees located on the campus for the summer season of 2026 only. the bidders may visit the campus with necessary permission and inspect the trees themselves on any working day before the submission of their bids.
- b) The bidders shall independently assess the number of fruit-bearing trees, the type and variety of mangoes, and the probable yield during the period between the opening date of the bid and the last date for submission of bids.
- c) The Institute does not guarantee any specific yield or business. However, the approximate quantity is provided for reference only. No complaints regarding quality or quantity will be entertained after the auction.
- d) The Bidder is informed to quote their offer price in the prescribed format only enclosed in Annexure-A. The Committee will evaluate the bids and offer the contract to the highest bidder.
- e) The successful bidder will have the right to harvest the mangoes. No ownership or rights over the land, trees, fruits beyond harvest, structures, or any other Institute property are granted.
- f) The Institute will not be responsible for theft, fire, natural calamities, or any other loss to the mango yield during the contract period. No refund of the bid amount will be entertained on these grounds.
- g) Harvesting must be carried out by the contractor or authorized laborers in the presence of Institute staff, without causing any damage to trees or plantation.
- h) The contractor must submit the names and details of authorized personnel. Only approved people will be permitted entry. The Institute reserves the right to deny entry of any personnel on security grounds.
- i) The contractor and workers must follow all Institute rules and regulations. They shall not interfere with regular farm or Institute operations.
- j) Sale of mangoes is strictly discouraged within the campus and near the Main Gate area. If required, prior permission should be obtained from the Institute.
- k) The contractor shall be fully responsible for any loss, damage, or pilferage caused to trees, land, or any Institute property during the contract period due to negligence. The assessed loss will be recovered from the contractor.
- l) The contractor should not bring prohibited items into the campus and should not use firewood for cooking or any other purpose. Violations will attract penalties as fixed by the Institute.
- m) The contractor is responsible for any accident arising due to negligence of himself/herself or workers and shall bear the damage as assessed by the Institute.
- n) The contractor must carry out harvesting at their own cost and arrange their own logistics.
- o) No accommodation will be provided inside the campus.

- p) The contract period will end on 15th July 2026. The Contractor should complete the harvesting within the stipulated period. Extension, if any, will be only with prior written approval of the Competent Authority. The contractor and workers must vacate the campus immediately after completion of the contract period.
- q) The Contractor shall not involve himself in any of the undesirable activities other than the harvesting of mangoes. Any violation will result in cancellation of the contract and forfeiture of the deposited amount.
- r) Any applicable taxes shall be borne by the successful bidder.
- s) In case of declared holidays, bandh, or unavoidable circumstances, scheduled dates may be extended to the next working day.
- t) The Institute reserves the absolute right to accept or reject any tender/bid, cancel the auction process at any stage without assigning any reason, and forfeit the security deposit/bid amount in case of violation of terms and conditions.
- u) Submission of the bid/participation in the auction implies that the bidder has read and accepted all the above terms and conditions.

Payment Terms:

The successful bidder (H1) shall be required to deposit 25% of the final value declared as H1 bidder on the same day of the auction as a confirmation of acceptance. The remaining 75% of the bid amount shall be deposited within two (2) working days thereafter. All payments shall be made through approved modes only, such as RTGS/NEFT/DD/Cheque or other digital payment (Google Pay/PhonePe) methods as specified in the NIDM. If the H1 bidder fails to deposit the balance 75% of the bid amount in stipulated time, the deposit will be forfeited, and the work will be awarded to H2 bidder. After completion and verification of payment details, the harvested mangoes will be permitted to go out of the campus through Gate 1.
