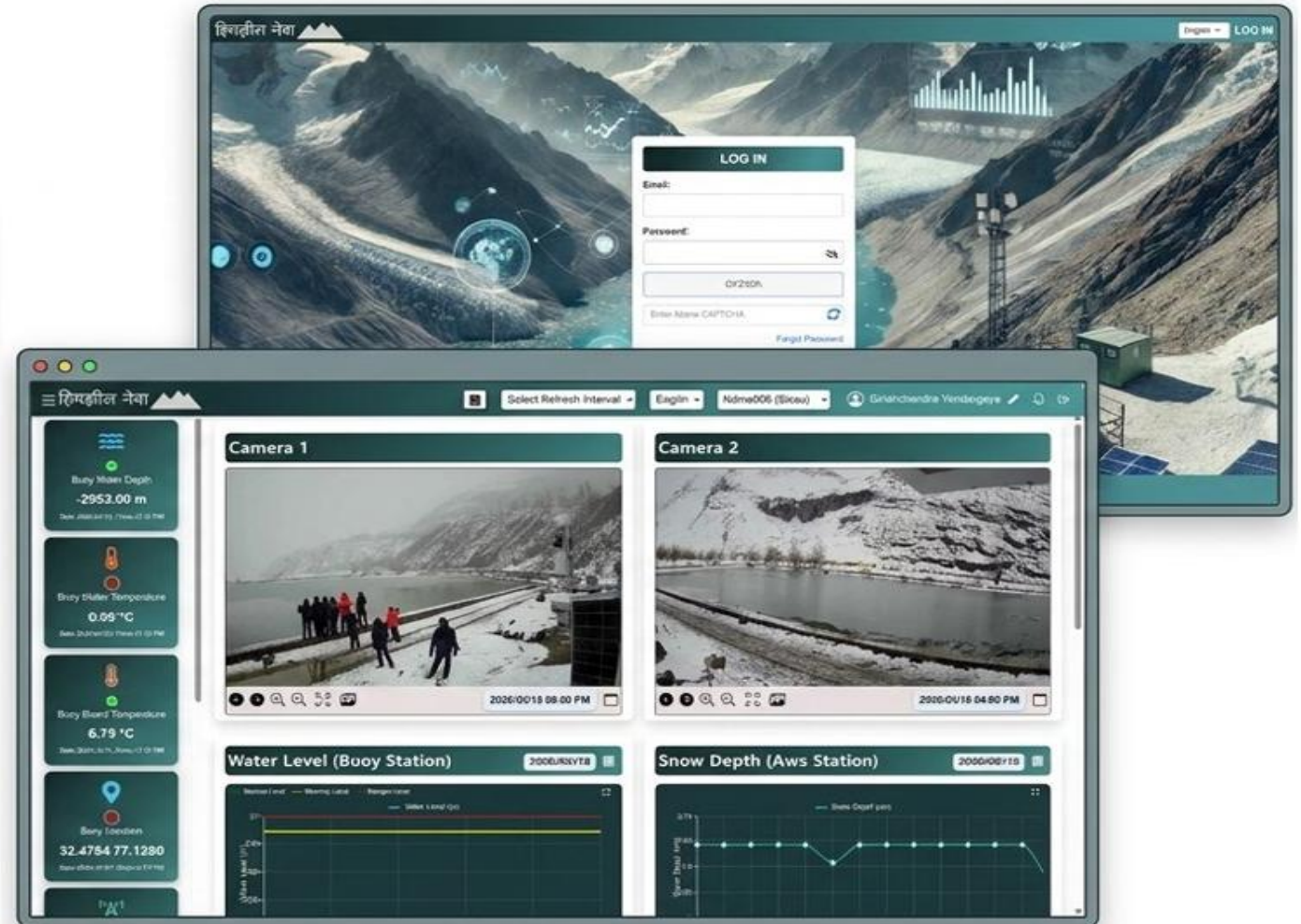
Unified Operational Dashboard

Multi-Agency Access: Secure login gateway granting specific visualization and query privileges to Central and State Agencies.

Real-Time Visuals: Live near real-time camera feeds directly from the Glacier Vision Unit (Camera 1 & 2).

Sensor Data Display & Analysis

Live graphical **Telemetry:** Live graphical charting of Buoy Water Level (vs. Danger Thresholds), Snow Depth from the AWS, and ambient acoustic levels.

Centralized Disaster Data Platform: DMIS is a comprehensive application for streamlined disaster data collection, verification, and reporting across multiple departments.

Field-to-Admin Workflow: Field staff can enter disaster-related data directly via mobile or web applications, which is then verified and consolidated by higher administrative levels.

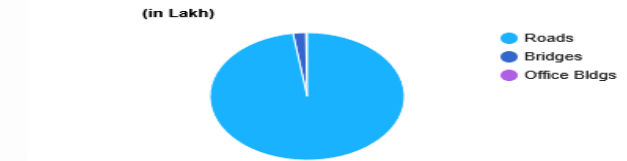
- **Hierarchical Workflow Structure**

- **Level 1 – Ground Level:** Section/Circle (*JE, AEO, HEO*)
- **Level 2 – Division/Block Level:** (*AE/EE, ADO, SMS*)
- **Level 3 – District/Zonal Level:** Review of aggregated data by District/Zonal
- **Level 4 – State Level:** (*Directors, Deputy Directors, Engineer-in-Chief*)

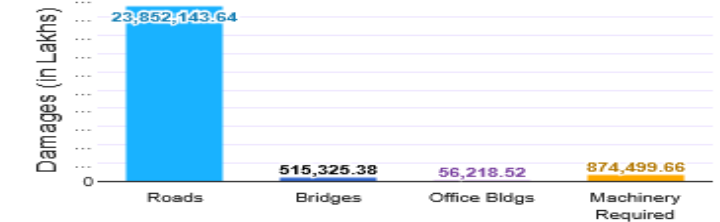
- **Key Functionalities**

- **Approval-Based Consolidation:** Data is validated and consolidated at each level
- **Editable Workflow:** Higher levels can **edit and augment** data from previous levels
- **Event Tagging:** Field-reported damages are tagged to **specific SDMA-identified disaster events**
- **Integrated Data Flow:** Ensures **accuracy, accountability, and real-time decision-making**

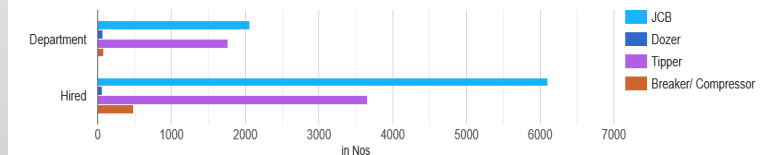
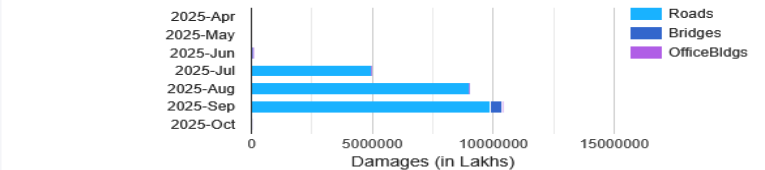
Asset wise Loss %

Month wise - Amount in Lakhs



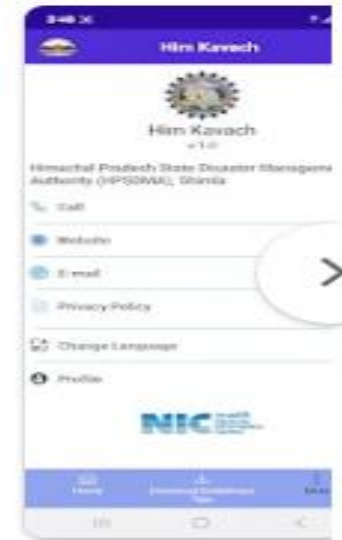

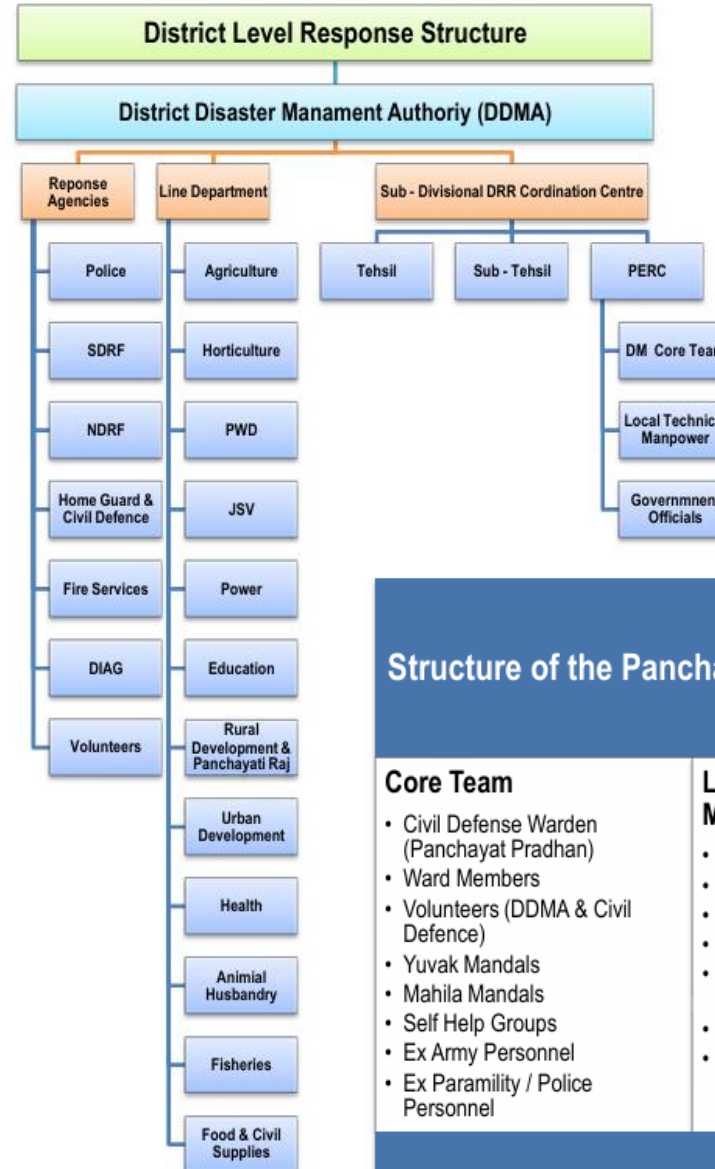

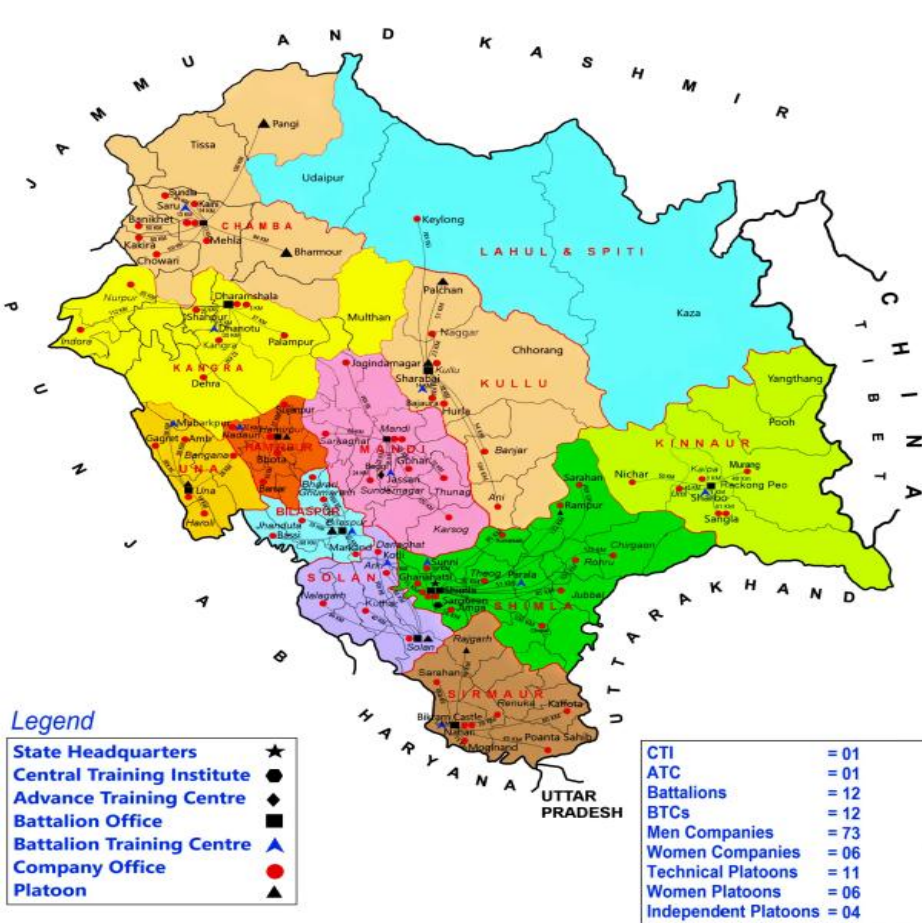

Initiatives for Promoting Safe Construction Practices in the State



- More than 300 Civil Engineers have been trained in safe construction practices at CBRI, Roorkee.
- To date, 150 engineers from HPPWD and the Rural Development Department have been trained under a specialized programme on Earthquake Retrofitting Techniques and DPR preparation.
- Under the scheme “Training of Masons, Carpenters & Bar Binders on Hazard-Resistant Construction,” a target has been set to train at least 5 masons per Panchayat. So far, 6,730 masons have been trained.
- A total of 12 Housing Facilitation Centres (HFCs) have been established across the State, covering almost every district at technical institutes under the same scheme, for mason training and for creating awareness among homeowners regarding safe construction practices.
- Regular Public Awareness and Training Programmes during SAMARTH & marking of Kangra Earthquake (4th April) as a Disaster Risk Reduction Day.
