ABOUT IDRN

IDRN is a web based platform for managing the inventory of equipment, skilled human resources and critical supplies for emergency response. The primary focus is to enable the decision makers to find answers on availability of equipment and human resources required to combat any emergency situation. This database also enables disaster managers to assess the level of preparedness for specific disasters.

NEED OF IDRN

India, due to its unique geo-climate conditions, is vulnerable to several types of disasters; floods, earthquakes, cyclones, landslides, tsunami, etc. The super cyclone of 1999, Bhuj earthquake of 2001, Kosi (Bihar) flood in 2008 and earthquake in Sikkim in 2011 have shown the need to build up capacity for handling disasters in more effective manner.

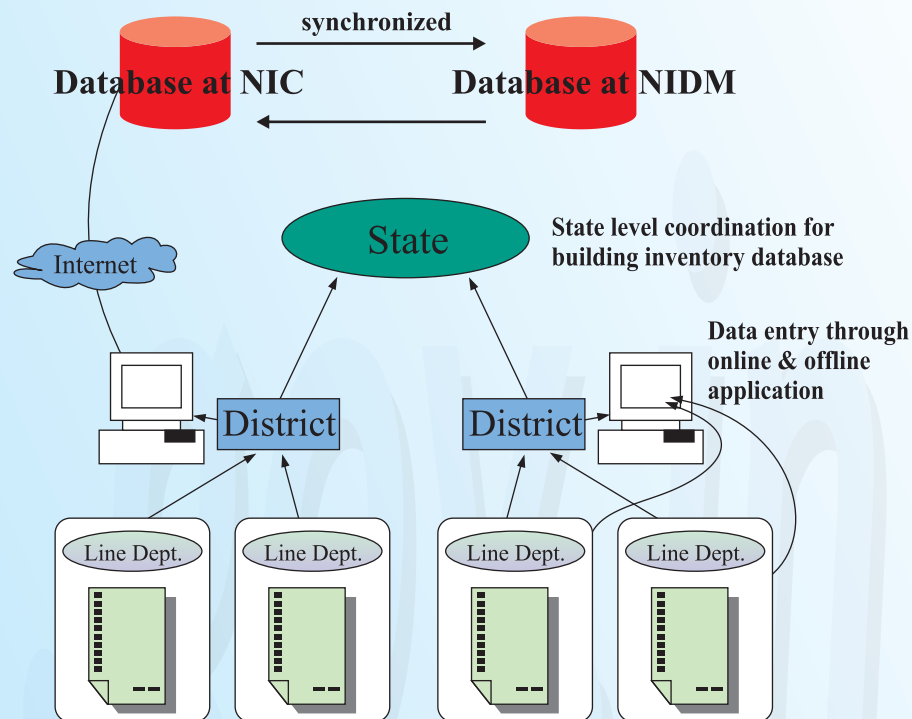
One of the major challenges in responding to disasters in a professional way is the lack of an inventory of resources (equipment and skilled human resource). This delays effective and rapid response, which is critical for saving lives. Therefore, need to build an inventory of resources that can help the district collectors and disaster managers was felt acutely and this resulted in developing of IDRN.

OBJECTIVE OF IDRN

IDRN was initiated by Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) in 2004 under the GOI -UNDP Disaster Risk Management (DRM) programme to build up a systematic inventory of equipment and skilled human resources so that disaster managers can find the location and details of the resources for immediate and effective response.

HOW IDRN WORKS ?

The online inventory of resources is hosted in the National Informatics Centre (NIC), New Delhi. Authorized Government officers have the access to update data in the Portal and the District Authority is responsible for the updating of data received from various line departments. Database is monitored at the central level by NIDM. Besides, NIDM is also responsible for the overall administration of the portal, including user administration.



IDRN MAINTENANCE

IDRN is currently monitored and maintained by NIDM. District Collector / Magistrate is the authorized officer for facilitating data collection and updation.

At present IDRN has about 1,42,984 records of all the districts. Provisions for the registration of Corporate Sector and Builders Association of India (CII & BAI) and private vendors are also included in the IDRN portal.

UPDATE DATA IN IDRN

All the district magistrates/collectors in the state are responsible to get the latest information about Disaster Management Resources available with various line departments/agencies uploaded in the portal, using services of District Informatics Officers.
