Tasks to be carried out:

- (a) Assist the Nodal faculty NIDM, Senior Consultant and Consultant associated with the preparation of policy/ knowledge document, under overall supervision of ED NIDM.
- (b) Assist in communication with the relevant officials in the different ministries/organisation/departments, authors, reviewers, and necessary meetings.
- (c) Collating data and information, compilation of the documents/ chapters and review comments, coordination with the officials for updating/ revision of documents, and cross-check of the same.
- (d) Assisting in the related administrative and other works as required from time to time.
- (e) Prepare periodic progress reports and reviews.
- (f) Any other related work assigned by the superiors, from time to time.
- (g) Maintain confidentiality of information/documents as per instructions.

Method of Engagement
