3-days online training programme on
“Telecommunication, radio and social media in disaster management”
From 04th – 06th November, 2020

Introduction

The growing multi-hazard environment to which millions of people in the world are exposed highlights the importance of making sure that the affected population is increasingly better prepared. Unplanned urbanization and industrialization, population expansion, environmental degradation, climate change, construction, development in high-risk zones, changing demographics and socio-economic conditions further increase the vulnerability of India to disaster (NDMA). The combination of human and economic losses, together with reconstruction costs, makes natural disasters both a humanitarian and an economic problem. In any disaster event, communication is a core component and plays a very crucial role in rescue, response and recovery operation. Media forges a direct link between the public and emergency organizations and plays a very important role in disseminating vital information to the public before, during and after disasters. Mass media such as newspapers, television, radio, community radio, internet, and social media are used quite extensively before, during and after a disaster event for broadcasting and dissemination of information. The media assists in the management of disasters by educating the public about disasters; warning of hazards; gathering and transmitting information about affected areas; alerting government officials, relief organizations and the public to specific needs; and facilitating discussion about disaster preparedness and response for continuous improvement.

This training programme is also the need of the hours as there is a need to focus on promotion of efficient, safe and resilient communication environment for emergencies and disaster situations, better linkage, coordination and cooperation among stakeholders and media for exchange of ideas, information, knowledge and experiences on disaster risk management, encouragement of the media to be partners in disaster relief, build a culture of proactive than reactive reporting culture, establishment of community based media and communication network throughout the nation ensuring last mile connectivity.

**3-days online training programme on
“Telecommunication, radio and social media in disaster management”
From 04th – 06th November, 2020**

National Institute of Disaster Management, Ministry of Home Affairs in collaboration with Department of Telecommunication, Ministry of Telecommunication successfully conducted 3-days online training programme on “Telecommunication, radio and social media in disaster management” from 04th – 06th November, 2020. Shri Chandra Shekhar, DDG(DM), DoT and Prof. Surya Parkash, Head, GMR Division, NIDM graced the inaugural session of the training programme. Sh. S. S. Jain, Director, DM, DoT; Shri Rajeev Kumar Shukla, Senior Media Person; Sh Atul Sinha DDG (Admin), DOT; Sh Shriphal Meena ADG (Disaster Management) Dr. Sandeep Baruah, Scientist – F, Vigyan Prasar; Prof. Surya Parkash, Head, GMR Division, NIDM; Dr. Harjeet Kaur, YP, NIDM; Anil Kathait, YP, NIDM and Raju Thapa, YP, NIDM shared their knowledge and experience in the technical session. Dr. Harjeet Kaur, YP, NIDM and Raju Thapa, YP, NIDM were the moderators of the programme. About 900 participants joined the programmes via cisco webex platform and about 875 viewed the YouTube telecast of the training programme. The details of the training programme are mentioned below.

Day-1, 04th November 2020

Inaugural Session

Mr. Raju Thapa, YP, GMR Division, NIDM moderated the first day of the training programme. He welcomed all the dignitaries in the three day online training programme on “Telecommunication, radio and social media in disaster management” and gave an introduction of the training



programme. He mentioned that the growing multi-hazard environment to which millions of people in the world are exposed highlights the importance of making sure that the affected population is increasingly better prepared.

Prof. Surya Parkash, Head GMR

Division NIDM, chair of this set the context of this training programme where he rightly underlined the need to focus on promotion of efficient, safe and resilient communication environment for emergencies and



disaster situations, better linkage, coordination and cooperation among stakeholders. He also highlighted media for exchange of ideas, information, knowledge and experiences on disaster risk management, encouragement of the media to be partners in disaster relief, build a culture of proactive than reactive reporting culture, establishment of community based media and communication network throughout the nation ensuring last mile connectivity.

Shri Chandra Shekhar, DDG

(DM), Department of Telecommunication, Ministry of Telecommunication highlighted that the Information and Communication Technologies (ICTs) play a significant role in disaster prevention, mitigation response and recovery.



Timely, predictable and effective information is much needed by government agencies and other humanitarian actors involved in rescue operations and decision-making processes.

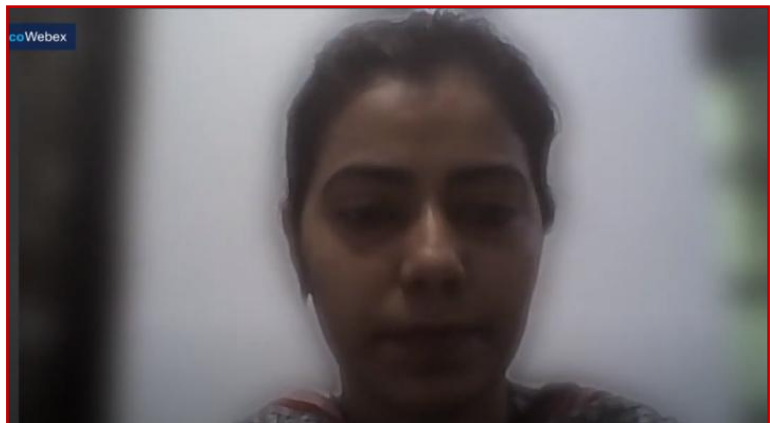
Technical Session

Sh. S. S. Jain Director, DM, Department of Telecommunication, Ministry of Telecommunication gave a detail presentation of Standard Operating Procedure (SOP-2015) for telecommunication services for Responding to disasters which has a mission “to minimize the impacts of



disasters on life, property, environment, and the economy through prompt provisioning and restoration of telecommunication Services in the disaster affected areas.” The disasters may cause enormous loss of life and property. He underlined that in the aftermath of a disaster, the telecommunication services are required on top priority and play a pivotal role in undertaking rescue, relief and rehabilitation measures. The role of Department of Telecommunications (DOT) is to act as a Lead/Primary agency for Emergency Support Function related to provision of telecommunication services by Telecom Service Providers and coordination with other Government agencies.

Dr. Harjeet Kaur, Young professional, GMR Division, NIDM talked about the HVCR *i.e.*, Hazard, Vulnerability, Capacity and Risk. During her lecture she focused on recognizing risk and hazard at our surrounding, evaluate risk at different level, strengthen our



coordination and corporation. During her lecture she also highlighted some tools that can be used in HVCR analysis area: focus group discussions, observation, interviews, questionnaires, secondary data etc.

Mr. Raju Thapa, YPs, GMR Division, NIDM during his lecture highlighted the basic of early warning and communication and standard operating procedures. During his lecture he highlighted that five main areas of intervention: Institutional and regulatory



arrangements to ensure a smooth early warning process and to develop capacity ructure; Community-based solutions to empower communities at risk and prompt an effective response to warnings; Private sector engagement to develop and manage EWS at lower costs and with the engagement of sectoral professionals; International co-operation and data sharing to minimize costs and to ensure greater impacts for EWS among stakeholders; Technological solutions to upgrade monitoring, forecasting, and warning infrastructure.

Day-2, 05th November 2020

On the second day of our training programme *i.e.*, 05th November, 2020, the first lecture was presented by **Sh. Anil Kaithat, YP, NIDM** where he discussed the role of social media in various aspects of emergency awareness and preparedness to connect, discuss, and



share knowledge in specific fields. Inappropriate communication and dissemination of warnings usually results in inappropriate (or absent) response. He also talked about the fake news in disaster situation and highlighted various ways to combat fake news.

Shri Rajeev Kumar Shukla,

ADG All India Radio talked about

response: planning as a first

response radio and he underlined

the role of radio in disaster

management. While highlighting



the crucial role of media in disaster risk prevention, forewarning, coverage, he mentioned the importance of radio during a disaster. He also highlighted that where no newspaper can go community radio can go. Disaster handling authorities need to be better acquainted with the working of not just radio broadcasting but also the dynamics and compulsions of different radio broadcasting organisations in the country and more importantly those active in their respective areas.

When emergencies like covid-19 and disaster strike, DOT has a strong and specific role to play in keeping communities up to date with events and advising them on practical steps to take to reduce the impact of a disaster. The CQAS offers many services, including automated email alerts for real-time quarantine geo-fence breaches to the authorities and catering to any mobile phone. The CQAS is assisting the State governments, Local governments and police for ground level enforcement of quarantine. It can prove to be a tech-savvy solution to monitor the movements especially in hotspot areas, without requiring physical presence of enforcement

teams in every nook and corner, thereby effectively utilizing the human resources in the fight against covid-19 pandemic.

Day-3, 06th November 2020

Sh. Shriphal Meena, ADG, Disaster Management, Department of Telecommunication, Ministry of Telecommunication

presented the first lecture in the third day of the training programme. During his presentation, he highlighted the



study conducted by DoT to monitor the migration of migrant labours during Covid pandemic scenario. In order to monitor quarantine-people, the local government agencies are using various tech based solutions like GPS-enabled monitoring apps, wrist-bands, CCTV surveillance, monitoring through drone-cameras and AI-based facial recognition systems. Several mobile applications in India are being developed for checking not only the locations of quarantine people but also for checking whether they are breaching the quarantine or not.

Dr. Sandeep Baruah, Scientist – F, Vigyan Prasasr

briefed about the ham radio with live demonstration and mentioned handiness of ham radio when in any emergency situation all other means of communications are hampered. He mentioned that Ham radio has



always been in the forefront whenever a disaster strikes, be it a flood, a cyclone, an earthquake or whatever kind of natural or manmade situation. With the capability of modern equipment to operate from very low batteries, the reliance on mains power is not there and so Hams are ideally equipped to work out in the field where basic amenities do not exist. Indian hams have always

rallied round in every possible emergency and their efforts have always been lauded. Ham radio is internationally accepted as the MAIN means of emergency communications and has proved it is invaluable in such situations.

Prof. Surya Parkash, Head, GMR Division, NIDM highlighted

that radio communication is very crucial in disaster preparedness and management. They can disseminate early warning and advisories to allow communities to prepare for natural hazards such as cyclones,



ahead of time. He also underlined that the community radio is the mass media that reaches the widest audience in the world and is also recognized as a powerful communication tool and a low cost medium. Radio is suited to reach remote communities and vulnerable people: the illiterate, the disabled, women, youth and the poor, while offering a platform to intervene in the public debate, irrespective of people's educational level.

Question and Answer session:

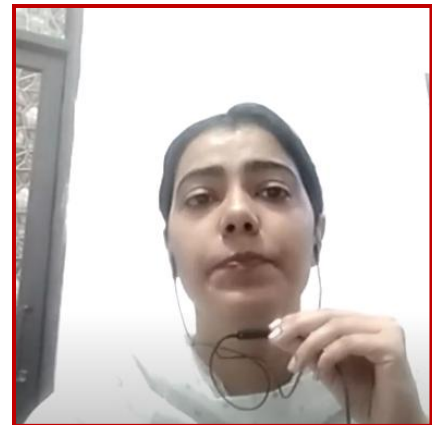
Mr. Raju Thapa, YPs, GMR Division, NIDM moderated the question and answer session. Some of the questions raised by the participants are as follows:



- Any training is provided to locals with regard to the telecommunication during a disaster? I mean other than the employees, whether the public will be trained for handling the situation?
- Is there any automatic alert during Disaster to all Mobile users??

- Who is authorised approve the list of Prority Call Routing from telecom side and from Government Side?
- How does Ham radio, Community radio helped remote/ rural/ semi urban areas of Indian Districts for fast Communication where Telecommunications is poor or has limited access?
- I have 2 radio set of short frequency, can i operate between them without license or I need permission to use this?
- Are there any assessment process or commettee that checks the status or progress of India in fullfilling the targets sets under these global framework
- Sir I have applied for the Licence about 3 months ago but still not received my licence, where can I get updates regarding this ? or is there any way to track my licence status? please reply
- Why can't we use Ham radio oparetors as disaster management members for emergency communication
- Can you elaborate on role of HAM Radio its role?

Dr. Harjeet Kaur, YP, GMR Division, NIDM proposed the vote of thanks and she expressed her gratitude towards ED, NIDM, Major General Monaj Kumar Bindal; Shri Chandra Shekhar, DDG (DM), DoT; Sh Shriphal Meena ADG (Disaster Management); Dr. Sandeep Baruah, Scientist – F, Vigyan Prasar; Sh Atul Sinha DDG(Admin), DoT; Shri Rajeev Kumar Shukla, Senior Media Person; Sh. S. S. Jain, Director, DM, DoT and entire NIDM team.



Key Takeaways:

Some of the important key takeaways that came out from the the three days training programme are as follows:

- Broadcasting techniques and systems for use in emergency communications needs to be continuously improvised.
- Initiative must be taken to create a network of amateur radio in India to strengthen community based disaster preparedness by reaching to the people and save life from natural disasters.
- NIDM need to focus in sharing of knowledge and information in local language to reach to the communities residing in remote areas with limited understanding of Hindi and English language.
- Collaboration and coordination between broadcasting organizations in emergency situations needs to be strengthen.
- There is need to provide information and instructions, with real time alerts and warning.
- There is need to provide situation awareness and monitoring/ early warning of disaster.
- Identifying volunteers for responding during the disaster needs to be carried out.
- Local innovation needs to be harnessed and integrated with new technologies wherever possible while strengthening early warning and communication system.
- There is need to promote utilization of social media for quick response and rescue measures helping in adapting to vulnerable situation.
- Educating society regarding rumor control during disaster response is very essential. There is a need to train and promote society to follow government organizations, official and credible source of information to get factual updates about what is happening in disaster situations.
- NIDM should carry out various Information Education Communication (IEC) activities to train-up media personnel to create contents and programs in disaster Management spreading information of disaster preparedness, education, health and other nationally important issues.
- Media should be treated as an equal, active, valuable, responsible and trusted partner in the realm of disaster management. Of course, the onus is on media too in this regard.

- Strengthening mechanisms for real time information sharing by these agencies with various media including radio organisations would facilitate faster communication and action thereon. Utmost care should be taken to include the radio stations/channels etc. serving the affected and/or vulnerable areas.
- Regular workshops and interactions for enhancing the skills of radio professionals will also go a long way in this.
- There can and should be a great value addition to the sop of air if apex agencies such as NDMA, NDRF, SDMAS, etc. Collaborate in improving and fine-tuning the sop on a regular basis.
- Community radio stations can provide last mile connectivity. In emergency situations, ham radio operators also can and do play a very important role.

INTRODUCTION

Early warning is a major element of disaster risk reduction. It can prevent loss of life and reduce the economic and material impacts of hazardous events including disasters. To be effective, early warning systems need to actively involve the people and communities at risk from a range of hazards, facilitate public education and awareness of risks, disseminate messages and warnings efficiently and ensure that there is a constant state of preparedness and that early action is enabled.

The Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015–2030 – the successor instrument to the Hyogo Framework for Action 2005–2015: Building the Resilience of Nations and Communities to Disasters – recognizes the benefits of multi-hazard early warning systems and enshrines them in one of its seven global targets [target (g)]: “Substantially increase the availability of and access to multi-hazard early warning systems and disaster risk information and assessments to people by 2030”. The Sendai Framework urges a paradigm shift in the way risk information is developed, assessed and utilized in

multi-hazard early warning systems, disaster risk reduction strategies and government policies. It states “in order to reduce disaster risk, there is a need to address existing challenges and prepare for future ones by focusing on monitoring, assessing and understanding disaster risk and sharing such information and on how it is created; strengthening disaster risk governance and coordination across relevant institutions and sectors and the full and meaningful participation of relevant stakeholders at appropriate levels”.

The programme involves senior level resource persons, experts, professionals and functionaries who have very long and meaningful experiences with vast knowledge on the subject. During the programme, there will be presentations, panel discussions and group exercises on planning for disaster management and its implementation issues with examples from India and abroad, sharing of ideas and expertise / skills related to disaster risk reduction and resilience with scope, advantages and limitations as well as issues, challenges and opportunities in managing disaster events including the ethical perspectives. Government of India has established a well-structured disaster management system defining roles, responsibilities and procedures for different stakeholders as well as allocation of adequate funds through different mechanisms for undertaking activities on DRR&R. It has also laid down guidelines, procedures and protocols for Disaster Management functionaries. The programme will provide information about such documents and key important points to be considered in disaster risk reduction and resilience.

It is expected that the programme would serve as a milestone for further actions in enhancing our capacities to reduce disasters and their impacts as part of the national goal to make the country disaster resilient through proactive prior planning on disaster risk reduction and resilience at proper place and time.

To promote community based broadcasting and communication for disaster risk reduction and resilience

- To promote knowledge dissemination, capacity building and networking towards disaster risk reduction and resilience
