### **Key Takeaways for Management of Biological disasters like COVID-19:**

- The COVID-19 epidemic proved to be an on-going spread of corona virus disease identified in 2019 (COVID-19). It was post the current pandemic that many people came to know that epidemic is a local outbreak of an infectious disease, but most of them are otherwise not aware that an epidemic is also classified as a category under biological disaster.
- The seriousness of the biological disaster such as COVID-19 outbreak had required all countries to engage in extensive prevention efforts.
- The policies of isolation, quarantine, social-distancing and area lockdowns have been adopted by many states.
- Psychological first aid, and psychosocial counseling and related awareness and education were key important aspect, which the current pandemic faced.
- Issues concerning cultures and religions also need to be emphasized in the subsequent biological disaster management plans.
- Biological disaster like SARS and COVID-19 not only has strong impact on mental health in those being infected and their family, friends, and co-workers, but also affect wellbeing in general public.
- Evidence are present which state that clear and timely psychosocial counseling and education, psychological first aid and psychological debriefing could ameliorate negative impact of many epidemics and also proved helpful amid COVID-19 pandemic.
- Hospitals and medical facilities must become better prepared to continue dealing with COVID-19 and future health risks and at the same time take steps so that effects of other natural hazards and subsequent disasters such as floods and cyclones impact on health services can be minimized in a Multi-hazard scenario.
- Local actors and front line workers on the ground, who are often the first to respond, must be empowered to act quickly with more autonomy and adequate resources in dealing with large-scale mass emergencies.

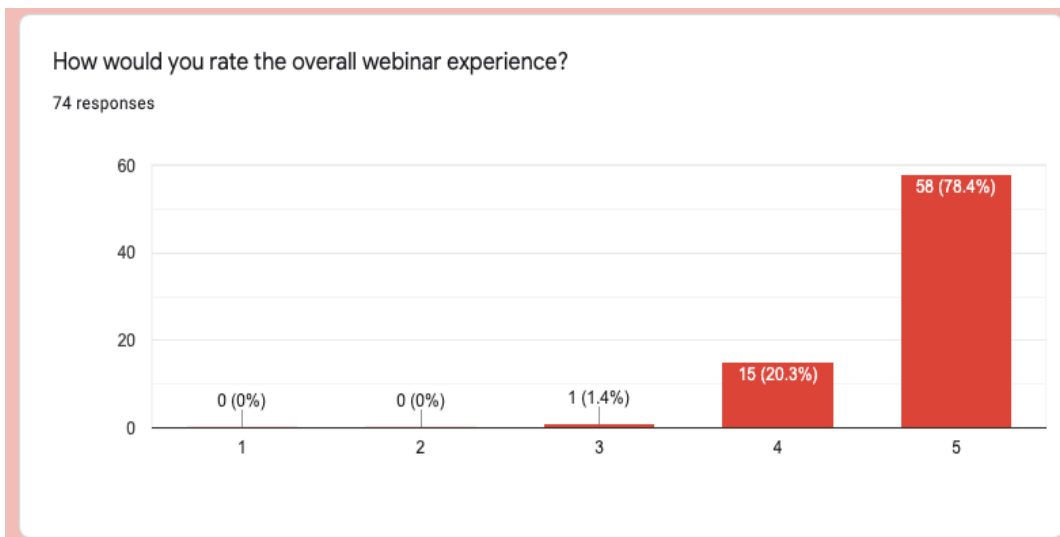
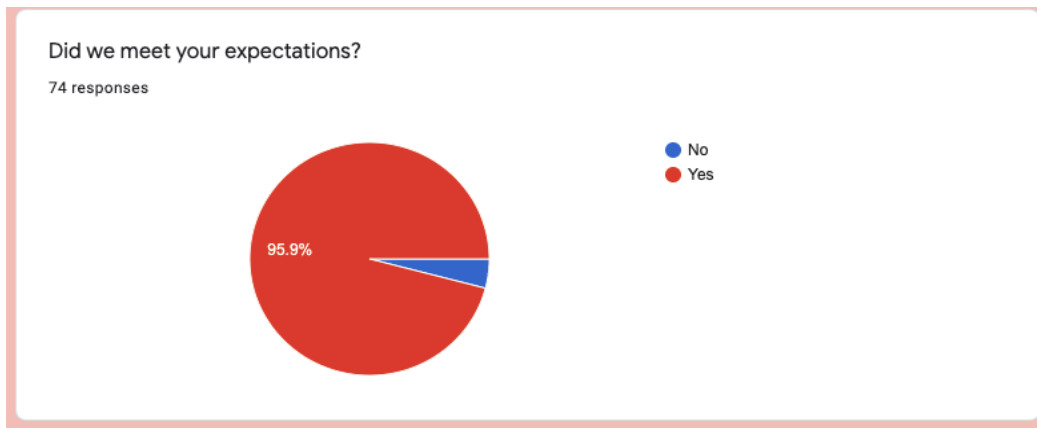
