PRESENTATIONS AND DISCUSSIONS MADE ON DAY 1 (10.03.2021):

During the 1st Day Session, various related points were discussed. Comprehensive Disaster Management (CDM) topics was elaborately discussed and presentations were made. The CDM is defined as the management of all hazards through all phases of the disaster management cycle – prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response, recovery and rehabilitation - by all peoples- public and private sectors, all segments of civil society and the general population in hazard prone areas. CDM involves risk

reduction & management and integration of vulnerability assessment into the development planning process.”

❖ **Mr. Arun Verma, Young Professional, NIDM had presented his topic on “Present Status & Basic Dos and Don’ts about COVID 19.**

Mr. Arun Verma delivered about the present status and basis dos and do nots about COVID 19 in the country and at global level. He clearly explained the measures being proposed by Government of India regarding safety of one and all.

❖ **Mr Shekher Chaturvedi, Asst Professors ,NIDM delivered his talk on “Disaster Management Concepts , Cycle and Vulnerability profile of India.**

In the presentation Mr S Chaturvedi presented nicely about the DM-Concepts, Cycle and Vulnerability profile of India. He explained that disasters know no boundaries. Man-made or natural, technological or chemical it can strike at any moment anywhere, paving destruction in the present as well as in the future. He also explained about concepts, cycle of disaster management.

Cycle- In this connection Mr Chaturvedi presented that a collective term encompassing all aspects of planning for and responding to disasters, including both pre (prevention, mitigation and preparedness) and post disaster (response, search and rescue, relief, reconstruction and rehabilitation) activities. It may refer to the management of both the risks and consequences of disasters

As regards **“Vulnerability Profile of India”** Mr Chaturvedi discussed that Vulnerability is a set of prevailing or consequential conditions that adversely affect people’s ability prevent, mitigate, prepare for and respond to hazardous events.

These long-term factors, weaknesses or constraints affect a household or community’s ability (or inability) also to absorb losses after disaster or to recover from the damage. Vulnerabilities precede disasters contribute to their severity, impede disaster response, and may continue to exist long after a disaster has struck.

He also explained the various vulnerability examples such as physical /material vulnerability, social /organizational vulnerability, Attitude or motivational vulnerability and the Capacity building.

❖ **Dr Girish Ch Mishra ,Asst.Dean School of Science, O P Jindal University, Raigarh had presented his talk on “Vulnerability Profile of Chhattisgarh”**

Dr Girish Ch Mishra briefly narrated that while addressing the programme. Dr Girish Ch Mishra made presentations about the vulnerability profile of the State of Chhattisgarh wherein he explained Climate change is proving out to be one of the greatest challenges faced by the global community today, past trends and current climatic events that changes being experienced in the climate of Chhattisgarh of natural climate variability prevailing in the state.

We have seen that for the state show that the Chhattisgarh is in precarious situation due to its high climate sensitivity and vulnerability, combined with

low adaptive capacity. The state is already suffering due to its high dependence on mineral resources.

Further the forest and water resources in the State are facing threat due to industrial and urban growth and being uneven in distribution both temporally and spatially.

Hence the challenge of climate change calls for appropriate, evidence based and coherent policy response, followed by the adequate action that can help reduce its vulnerability and build resilience of the various sectors of the state in the context of climate change impacts.

Dr Mishra ended his presentations with thanks to the audiences present during the programme.

The Day 1 Session was concluded successfully with Question & Answer Session put up by the participants and sorted out by the speakers.

Day 2 –PRESENTATIONS AND DISCUSSIONS MADE (11.03.2021):

DAY-2 SPEAKERS :

During the 2nd Day Session -

Shri Ashish Panda Faculty NIDM, presented his topic on “Disaster Psycho-social Issues” and explained various issues and its management during the presentation.

In the 2nd Day Session Mr Ashish Panda delivered a talk on :’Disaster Psycho-social Issues’ related to comprehensive disaster management. He explained and discussed the details of the issues that disaster-affected people experience various psychological reactions. These reactions immediately follow the event while socio-economic impacts like lack of employment; homelessness, environmental destruction and disorganization emerge as a consequence, following the devastation caused by the disaster.

The emotional reactions should be understood based on the manifestation of various stress reactions, level of effort put by the people for their own reconstruction, the pattern and amount of disability created due to these psychological stress etc. along with various issues related to disasters.

Shri Panda also explained about the psychological care and disaster risk reduction very nicely. He also narrated that the rescue, relief and rehabilitation are usually being

carried out after any disaster, it is crucial to create a pool of human resources to respond to the psychosocial needs of the survivors. This is not only a need of the community but also a responsibility of the civil society and the State to support the affected communities to rebuild the shattered lives of the survivors. Supporting the psychosocial needs of the survivors should always be ensured in a holistic care approach to ensure the normalization and speedy recovery after the disaster.

In the remarks of his presentations, Shri Panda had given the plans of the government policy matters is to take priority action for the affected people. He also pointed out the present scenario and the role concerned authority from upper level to bottom, their involvement, responsibility in a streamlined way to cope with the situation and to render support to the affected people/community/individual.

Shri Vikram Gurjar, Dy. Commandant, NDRF delivered his presentations on “ Institutional Framework” related to Comprehensive Disaster Management , its role and responsibility and other systems of management to deal with the situation. He explained various other issues elaborately while presenting the topics in the programme.

Institutional Frame work : Shri Vikram Gurjar in his deliberations told that the basic responsibility for undertaking rescue, relief and rehabilitation measures in the event of a disaster rests with the concerned State Government. The Central Government supplements the efforts of the State Governments by providing logistic and financial support in case of severe natural calamities. The logistic support includes deployment of aircrafts, specialist teams of Armed Forces, Central Para Military Forces and personnel of National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), arrangements for relief materials & essential commodities including medical stores, restoration of critical infrastructure facilities including communication network and such other assistance as may be required by the affected States to meet the situation effectively.

He presented all the institutional framework are well equipped and the plan and policies have been formulated to take up the matter as and when required. He also put up examples of the government in this regard and ended his presentations with thanks to the attendees during the period.

Mr.Shekher Chaturvedi, Asstt. Professor, NIDM presented his topic on “ Disaster Management Plan, Importance and its Structure pertaining to Comprehensive Disaster Management. During his presentations Shri Chaturvedi vividly presented the issues, its management, plan , structure and its importance in managing the disaster .

The National Disaster Management Plan (NDMP) aims to make India disaster resilient and significantly reduce the loss of lives and assets. The plan is based on the four priority themes of the “Sendai Framework,” namely: understanding disaster risk, improving disaster risk governance, investing in disaster reduction (through structural

and non-structural measures) and disaster preparedness, early warning and building back better in the aftermath of a disaster.

He also pointed out that NIDM's main vision is to make India disaster resilient, achieve substantial disaster risk reduction, and significantly decrease the losses of life, livelihoods, and assets – economic, physical, social, cultural, and environmental – by maximizing the ability to cope with disasters at all levels of administration as well as among communities.

Shri Chaturvedi also explained the importance and its structure so far as disaster management is concerned and various points were given during the course of the presentations.

As regard of importance, Shri Chaturvedi explained that **disasters** are events that are unpredictable most of the times. It is **important** for any government, state or community to manage **disasters** by being prepared for it in advance. The government provides legislation, allocates resources and does the rational planning and sustainable development.

In the concluding session of the day-2, the question and answer session began with questions from the visiting audiences presented in the programme which were clarified and sorted out by the presenters of the training programme during the day-2.

PRESENTATIONS AND DISCUSSIONS MADE –DAY 3:

Dr Girish Chandra Mishra, Asstt.Dean-School of Science – Topic ‘ Women and DRR’ – while presenting the deliberations during the 3rd Day of the Session Dr Mishra gave a presentation in detail with regard to the role and the responsibility, importance, preparedness and capacity building by the women in disaster risk reduction and its management. He also discussed nicely the performance of the women in mitigating all the related issues.

In his presentations, Dr Mishra explained that **Women** are important agents for change and need to be further strengthened as such. We must recognize and mobilize their skills and capacities as social force and channeling it to enhance efforts to

protect their safety and that of their communities and dependants which is a major task in any disaster reduction strategy.

Dr Mishra also explained about DRR and told that **Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR)** aims to reduce the damage caused by natural hazards like earthquakes, floods, droughts and cyclones, through an ethic of prevention. Disasters often follow natural hazards.

Ethical Principles of DRR - The aim of ethical principles applied to disaster risk reduction is to strengthen the resilience of populations in the event of a likely natural and technological disaster, by giving an ethical content to the risk reduction measures, such as **prevention**, assistance, reduction of vulnerability and reconstruction, centred.

In the concluding presentation, he welcomed once again the audiences, the team members of NIDM, OPJU and other attendees for their presence and sparing the time .

Dr S K Singh, Professor Humanity and Dean –Student Affairs, O P Jindal University spoke about the topic ‘Community Based Approach for DRR’. In his presentations, he explained DRR in community based approach is a process, which leads to a locally appropriate and locally "owned" strategy for disaster preparedness and risk reduction. It also covers a **community-based** approach to project and programme planning for relief, recovery and resettlement.

In addition to the above he also told about CBDRM approach which covers prevention and mitigation, preparedness, emergency response and recovery. Also told about the key aspects - community involvement, the **sustainability** of community level initiatives for disaster reduction.

Dr S K Singh concluded his presentations with thanks for giving his opportunity for joining this programme.
