

TARGET GROUP

Participants may be drawn from line departments and institutions at the State and district levels, including officials from Panchayati Raj, Education, Agriculture, Women & Child Development, Water Resources, Veterinary Departments, NYK, NCC, NSS, as well as faculty members from SIRDs, DIRDs, Panchayati Raj Training Institutions, Extension Training Centres, and Aapda Mitra Instructors. Preference may be given to individuals possessing prior training experience, facilitation skills, field-level engagement, and communication abilities, as these qualities are essential for developing a strong pool of competent trainers. Potential trainers with the aptitude and motivation to undertake capacity-building roles in future may also be nominated.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Strengthen understanding of disaster risk management concepts, frameworks, and institutional mechanisms.
- Develop capacities in hazard, risk, vulnerability, and capacity analysis.
- Enhance understanding of climate risks, mitigation frameworks, and resilient development.
- Build competencies in training design, facilitation, and participatory learning methodologies.
- Promote teamwork, communication, leadership, and problem-solving through practical exercises.
- Develop a pool of master trainers for disaster risk reduction and capacity-building programmes.

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE

The proposed Master Trainer Programme is a comprehensive capacity development initiative integrating Disaster Management (DM) knowledge with professional trainer development skills. The programme aims to develop a pool of skilled Master Trainers capable of delivering quality training programmes, mentoring frontline functionaries, and strengthening preparedness and resilience at all levels.

With increasing disaster risks due to climate change, urbanization, technological hazards, and socio-economic vulnerabilities, there is a growing need for professionals equipped with both technical expertise and effective training competencies. The programme addresses this need through an integrated approach combining disaster risk reduction concepts with adult learning and facilitation methodologies.

The DM component will cover key areas such as the Disaster Management Act, NDMP, Sendai Framework, climate change adaptation, preparedness and response systems, community-based DRR, recovery planning, and emerging risks including urban floods and heatwaves. The trainer development component will focus on participatory training techniques, facilitation and communication skills, training design, simulation exercises, preparation of training materials, and assessment methods.

The programme is expected to strengthen decentralized capacity-building systems, enhance the quality of disaster management training, and promote a culture of preparedness and resilience across sectors.
